In your child's cubby please remember to send a change of clothes in case of accident. Also remember to check the white box for papers and important notes daily. Skill cards will sent home on Friday. If the children get all their work done, they will have a sticker on their skill card. We ask you to encourage your child to get a sticker each week.

Our job becomes one of providing positive guidance to foster the love of learning and the work cycle (choose an activity, work on it until finished, and put it away). Enhancing these values, both socially and educationally is our greatest challenge and pleasure.

Each month you will receive a lesson/snack plan, highlighting special activities for each day and indicating your child's snack day for the month. Each family is responsible for providing snack (from 2 food groups) for 18 children. We are happy to give suggestions as to what foods and how much to bring.

Small, thin flannel blankets are needed for use during nap time. No toys or stuffed animals please. Blankets are stored in the boxes at the bottom of your child's cubby.

During the day, potty accidents or juice or water spills can occur. Regression in toileting skills often occurs when children begin Preschool because they are so interested in learning that they forget. For this reason, every preschool child must have two complete change of clothes available, labeled and stored in their cubby. We will work with each child and family as necessary, so please indicate any special needs your child has in this area.

We would like to welcome you and your child to Early Preschool. Working with 2 year olds is so rewarding. Their energy level and enthusiasm is incredible. They are learning to communicate verbally and the things they say are a often very funny. They are discovering how to get what they want and set up boundaries. At this age they are guided to use one activity at a time and work independently. We look forward to the challenge.

Monthly lesson plans will be given out which show your child's snack day. Each family is responsible for providing snack for 14 children. If your child misses a snack day, please send a non-perishable snack to use at a later time. Show & Tell should fit in your child's cubby.

When your child is ready for potty training, we will need several pairs of training pants, rubber pants and extra changes of clothing. You can send in a bag of disposable diapers and we will store the extras. Each child will have his own labeled container and we will send home a note when he/she needs more.

Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for both inside and outside play. Your child's coat, lunch box and two small blankets should be kept in your child's cubby. Mats are provided. Blankets should be taken home on Fridays to be washed. Please be firm and help your child leave toys, and jewelry at home. It is best to establish this rule at the beginning of the year. Also remember to pack foods that can be handled and eaten easily and are age-appropriate for your child. Please cut up your child's food into bit-sized pieces. Be sure to label each container and lid with your child's name.

Located near the front door is the sign-in book and parent bulletin board. Please leave notes for us in the sign-in book. There are 2 clip boards in the diaper changing area. They have daily information on diaper changing and naps. We will leave comments for you on these boards.

Welcome to the Toddler Room at Countryside. Our main goal is help the children discover who they are and to love that wonderful little self that they find. They will learn that its not okay to hurt themselves or others, how to eat with utensils, how to put things away, and how to sit for circle with ever increasing attention spans. This is a time of constant change and development for your child. Parents find it extremely difficult realizing the metamorphosis from baby to toddler. We are aware of this and are here to discuss anything on any level. We love your children and we welcome them to our class with much enthusiasm.

Your child will begin speaking and learn to use words to communicate. This is an exciting, frustrating and difficult time both for parents and children. Pacifiers are fine but we do encourage the children to do without them. Please send your child's lunch in a labeled, insulated lunch box complete with an ice pack and a spill proof cup containing what you'd like your child to drink. Also remember to pack foods that can be handled and eaten easily and are age-appropriate for your child. Please send no glass containers. Label everything in the lunch box that needs to go home.

A diaper chart is located on a clipboard by the changing table. Diaper changes, snacks, and comments on each child are charted daily. Please feel free to leave notes for us on this chart. We will send home notes if your child needs something. Please bring disposable diapers. Lunch boxes should be placed on the shelf above the lunch tables. Outer wear and nap blankets are kept in the child's cubby. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for both inside and outside play. Snap crotch pants need to have strong snaps and be baggy. Sheets and blankets are sent home each Friday for laundering.

Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for both inside and outside play. We will take them out on the covered toddler playground daily. Also send 2 complete changes of clothes to be kept at Countryside. Remember to label each item. If your child is in need of something, we will note it on the daily log. The daily log, found in each child's cubby or on the clipboard, tells how much your child ate and drank, slept, what activities your child did, as well as other important information. Please take home your child's individual record daily.
